

**Tiny Term Installation Notes for Tag-n-Trak
LAN (Telnet) Connection (ethernet or wireless)**

1. Insert CD and follow installation instructions. (See also Page 1 of TinyTerm Quick Start Guide.) This basically involves pressing the NEXT key and accepting all of the defaults. You will have to enter the serial number and activation key.
2. Next, go to Desktop, Start. Do a shutdown and restart your PC.
3. After the reboot, go to **Start, Programs, TinyTERM** and highlight **TinyTERM Emulator**.
4. After the TinyTerm blue screen comes up, Click on **File, Open Session, WIZARD**.
5. Follow the Wizard prompts:
 - Connection type = **Telnet**
 - Host Name or IP Address = **xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx** (where xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx is the Tag-N-Trak server's LAN IP address; you must have an ethernet or wireless network configured to work with the Tag-N-Trak server)
 - Terminal Emulation = **WYSE60**
 - Cursor type/style = **Block** or **Blinking Block**
 - Leave User Name and Password **BLANK**. Do **NOT** use Auto Login.
 - File Name to save = **tnt**
 - Click **Finish**
6. Click on **File** and **Save As...**
7. Click on the icon **Desktop**.
8. Next, change the **File** name (displayed as default.tpx) to **TNT.tpx** and then click on the **Save** button.
9. Next, click on **Edit, Session Properties**.
10. Check "**Establish Connection on Open**" & "**Close session on disconnect and exit**"
11. Click on **Attributes folder**. Set up attributes as follows:

Attribute	Display Attribute	Brightness	Foreground	Background
NORMAL	None (no checks)	High	YELLOW	BLUE
REVERSE	Reverse	Low	LT BLUE	WHITE
BOLD	None (no checks)	Normal	WHITE	BLUE

12. Click on **Fonts folder**. Highlight TermCS1 and then click on Up. Click on **Apply**.
13. If still in **Session Properties**, **Close** it. Next, Click on **File** and **Save Session**. Press Enter. You should get a login. Log in to **Tag-n-Trak**.
14. **Exit from Tag-n-Trak by pressing 8 Exit to Operating System at Main Menu**. Close your TinyTerm session (click on X in upper right corner).
15. You should see a **TNT.tpx** icon on your **Desktop**. Double-Click the **TNT.tpx** icon. The Tiny Term Century logo should display briefly following by a Login prompt.
